MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE 32 RESIDENTS

1. Apologies : None
2. Minutes of Last Meeting : Taken as read and signed as a correct record
3. Chairman's Introduction and report : The Chairman delivered the attached report, which included a reference to disturbance being caused around the Village by drones.
4. Door Step Crime : The Meeting appreciated the Video presentation by Paul Unwin of Cheshire East Council.
5. What do you want from your Parish Council : Parish Clerk led a discussion to obtain guidance from the residents on their expectations from their Parish Council. After little constructive response Cllr Levis guided discussion towards Village communications and some interest was expressed in the introduction of a Village App to help ensure information was efficiently passed to Residents.
6. United Charity report : Chairman of the Charity Cllr Morgan produced the attached accounts and reported that no applications had been received in over twelve months for financial assistance. The Charity commissioners have advised that the income should be distributed and a suggestion has been made that the funds ought to be directed to the Cheshire Community Foundation. The Trustees will give consideration to this and other proposals to utilise the Charity funds within the Charity objectives.
7. Village Hall report : Chairman of the Village Hall Management Committee Cllr Hatton advised that the Village hall finances were in a strong position and plans have been agreed to improve the Car Parking on the field at the rear of the Hall.
8. Matters raised from the floor : The matter of further Car Parking at the Crescent Bungalows was raised and the matter would be referred to Peaks and Plains. Concern expressed that D&G Transport will cease in July to run the Village Bus service and it will revert to Cheshire East. Efforts must be made to retain the service. There being no other business the meeting was closed.
